**GUIDELINES FOR ENTRY:**

Are you someone who always has a thousand ideas and plans?  
Do you believe that the wonderful talent of people can make a difference today?  
Enter and maybe your product will be chosen, manufactured, marketed and sold to create employment. You can win wonderful prizes and also help to make people aware of the importance of creating employment and of recycling, repairing, reducing and re-using.

**Brief:**

Design and produce a surface or product from waste material or found objects that can be manufactured by unemployed people.  
Send your entry form, sketches of your design and photographs of your product to P.O Box 426 George 6530 to reach us before 15 July 2011.

**Guidelines and tips**

- You must design and produce a functional surface or product that is also interesting and aesthetically pleasing enough so that consumers would buy it.
  - Your surface or product must be manufactured by hand only. You can use any type of materials, but they must come from a sustainable source in your community and must be free. (Old clothes, upholstery material, wire and plastic- anything-as long as it is free, because production by hand is time consuming and costly.) You are trying to rid the environment of waste and rubbish.
  - Your entry must include all sketches showing your design process and also a detailed production process.
  - Craft techniques like knitting, crochet and weaving are very trendy today and are easily taught as new skills.
  - Participants are encouraged to express new and individual designs.
  - Finalist's products must be packed safely and securely to avoid breakages.
- Applicants may submit as many entries as they wish. However, each entry must be labelled and accompanied by its own entry form.  
If applicants enter as a team, all names and ID's must appear on the entry form. Prize money will be shared by members in the group.
- Criteria for judging: Choice of material, innovation and aesthetics, commercial viability and functionality.**

**GENERAL INFORMATION:**

A first selection of entries will be done from photographs of your product.  
The selected products will be judged by a panel of professionals working in the field of design. Finalists and winners will be chosen by this group.  
-Winners will be announced at the Libere banquet on the 13<sup>th</sup> of August 2011.  
-The winning entries will become the property of Libere Foundation.  
The finalists and winning designs will be on display at the Libere Art, Décor and Fashion Festival on 12 and 13 August 2011 in George.
