

PNA Battle of the Gees Competition Terms and Conditions:

1. Eligibility:
 - a. Open to all registered Primary and High Schools in South Africa and Namibia. No Preschools are allowed to enter.
 - b. Schools may submit one entry only.
 - c. The War Cry video should be a new original video. (Never been published or used before)
2. How to Enter:
 - a. Schools must submit a video showcasing their War Cry or school spirit via the official PNA website.
 - b. Entries must feature a banner made using products purchased from PNA.
 - c. A complete entry form is required
 - d. Entry period: 1-30 May 2025
3. Banner Guidelines:
 - a. Banners must be handmade using items available at PNA (e.g. poster, pens, paints, etc.).
 - b. The banner must be visible in the War Cry video and accompanying photos.
4. Voting & Winner Selection:
 - a. Public voting will take place on PNA's Facebook page.
 - b. Voting is based on the total number of likes received on PNA's official Facebook page (excluding stories and reels).
 - c. Voting Period: 4 – 10 June
 - d. Winners will be announced during the week of 16 June 2025.
 - e. One Primary School and one High School will be selected as winners.
5. Prizes:
 - a. Each winner will receive a promo video and lunch for all the kids in the school.
6. Disqualification & Fair Play:
 - a. Any fraudulent activity, including fake engagement or votes, will result in disqualification.
 - b. Voting and entry activity will be verified.
7. Consent & Usage:
 - a. By submitting an entry, schools consent to PNA using submitted content (video, photos, banners, school name) for marketing purposes across all platforms.
 - b. Parental or school consent must be obtained before submitting videos or photos of minors.
8. General:
 - a. This is a digital-only campaign. No in-store activations are required.
 - b. PNA reserves the right to update or amend the campaign terms if necessary without prior notice to any entrant.
